Charleston, Savannah, Jekyll Island

Day One - Travel to Charleston / Carriage Tour / shopping in the Old Market / seafood dinner at AW Shucks.

Today we travel to beautiful Charleston, SC. When we arrive we will take a Carriage Tour of the Historic District followed by shopping at the Old Market and dinner at AW Shucks. We cross the beautiful new Cooper River Bridge to our overnight stay in Mount Pleasant (D)

Day Two - Magnolia Gardens and Plantation / Charleston Tea Plantation / Citadel / Dinner Cruise on Charleston Harbor

This morning we take a tour of the beautiful and historic Magnolia Plantation, including a visit to the house and gardens. We also visit the Charleston Tea Plantation and the Citadel. This evening we enjoy a harbor dinner cruise. (CB, D)

Day Three - Travel to Savannah / Guided Tour of Savannah / River Dinner Cruise

We arrive in Savannah late morning and visit the Welcome Center for orientation and then to lunch at Paula Deen's "Lady and Sons." This afternoon we enjoy a guided tour. In the evening we spend time on famed River Street before taking a Dinner Cruise aboard Georgia Queen. (CB, L, D)

Day Four - Tour Fort Pulaski / St. Simons Island

Today we visit historic Fort Pulaski. Named after the Revolutionary war hero Gen. Casimir Pulaski, and built by a young army engineer Lt. Robert E. Lee, this National Historic Monument has stood at the mouth of the Savannah River for almost 180 years. This afternoon we start our tour of the Golden Isles with a visit to St. Simons Island. (CB, D)

Day Five—Tour Millionaire's Village and Jekyll Island / Return to North Georgia

We relive the hunting cottages of the Gilded Age when we visit Millionaire's Village and tour Jekyll Island. This afternoon we return to North Georgia. (CB)
