### Day One - Travel to Louisville, KY

We invite you to a Signature Tour of the great state of Michigan. We will travel through Tennessee and Kentucky to overnight near Louisville, KY

### Day Two - Holland Michigan

We continue north through the heartland of America as we travel through Indiana and southern Michigan on our way to the Tulip capital of America, Holland, MI. where we enjoy a two night stay (CB)

### Day Three - Holland Tulip Festival

We are in Holland on the first day of the famed Holland Tulip Festival. That means we hopefully will enjoy the beautiful gardens at their peak, before the massive crowds arrive mid-week for the parades and concerts. We will tour the famed Veldheer Tulip Gardens and Dutch Village. We will return to our hotel to freshen up for a wonderful dinner. (CB, D)

### Day Four - Visit Silver Lake Sand Dunes / Old Mackinac Point Lighthouse / Colonial Fort Michilimackinac

We enjoy a wonderful morning drive along the shore of Lake Michigan and the Silver Lake Sand Dunes. This afternoon we visit Fort Michilimackinac, a living history museum, followed by a visit to Old Mackinaw Point Lighthouse, overlooking the famous Mackinaw Bridge. Arrive at our Mackinaw City hotel for a two night stay( CB, D)

### Day Five -Mackinaw Island / Carriage Tour / Fort Mackinaw / lunch at the Grand Hotel

A visit to beautiful Mackinaw Island is a charming visit reminiscent of a bygone era. Our modern ferry will deliver us to the quaint streets of downtown, where we board a horse drawn carriage for a tour of this spectacular island. After a tour of Fort Mackinaw a carriage will take us to one of the finest hotels in America,

the Grand Hotel. There you will enjoy a wonderful buffet lunch. You are on your own for the afternoon to explore the hotel and the shops of downtown. After dinner we return to our hotel (B, L, D)

**Day Six - Sault St Marie / Frankinmuth** This morning we cross the “Big Mac Bridge” and travel to Sault St Marie, MI and the famous Soo Locks. The St Mary’s River flows from Lake Superior to Lake Huron and falls 21 feet, creating impassable rapids. The historic Soo Locks were built to allow shipping access to and from Lake Superior. You will take a boat tour through these impressive locks. This afternoon we head south to the Bavarian village of Frankinmuth. We will have dinner and overnight in Frankinmuth (CB, D)

### Day Seven - Bronner Christmas Store / Dearborn’s Greenfield Village

After a visit to Bronner Christmas Store we travel to one of Bobby’s favorite stops, the Greenfield Village/ Ford Museum. This is one of greatest museums of the ‘Industrial Age’ in the world. Founded by Henry Ford, this fabulous indoor & outdoor living museum offers a unique look at development of everything from sewing machines to airplanes. We overnight in Dearborn this evening (CB, D)

### Day Eight - Tour Fair Lane, the home of Henry Ford- lunch at Ford Mansion - travel to Cincinnati

This morning we stroll through the spacious rooms where Clara & Henry Ford entertained some of the world’s most influential people. Explore the six-level power house, including Mr. Ford’s personal garage and cars. See the giant generators placed by Henry Ford and Thomas Edison that still generate electricity today. We have lunch at Fair Lane before starting our return home. Tonight we overnight just south of Cincinnati (CB, L)

### Day Nine - Return to North Georgia

We will travel through the beautiful Blue Grass Country of Kentucky and through the mountains of Tennessee as we return to our north Georgia points of origin. (CB)
