**DAY ONE - Travel to Virginia**

Our Nova Scotia Tour is one of most charming tours we conduct. This morning you will meet your fellow travelers and learn about the interesting places we will visit.

We overnight in central Virginia. (D)

**DAY TWO - Travel to Connecticut**

This morning we drive through Virginia, Maryland, Delaware, New Jersey and New York to our overnight stay near Hartford, CT (CB, D)

**DAY THREE - Travel to southern Maine /Down East Clam Bake.**

Our travels today take us through New England to southern Maine, where we will enjoy a traditional Down East Clam Bake. We overnight in Maine. (CB, D)

**DAY FOUR - Travel to Bar Harbor ME**

After visiting beautiful Freeport ME we travel to the beautiful, charming resort town of Bar Harbor ME. (CB, L)

**DAY-FIVE - Ride "The CAT" to Yarmouth Nova Scotia**

This morning we board one of the most modern open ocean ferries in the world, "The CAT." This outstanding ship will take us (and the coach) to the historic town of Yarmouth, NS. You will want to be near a window as we approach the beautiful Nova Scotia shoreline. You will first see the lighthouse, and then the charming village of Yarmouth. After arrival our local guide will provide a tour of this historic town. (CB, D)

**DAY SIX - Travel the Evangeline Trail to Halifax**

Our ride today will take us along the north shore, made famous by Longfellow's poem, Evangeline. Today, you will also pass through one of the oldest towns in North America, Annapolis Royal where we enjoy lunch in the Historic Gardens. Tonight we arrive in Halifax for a two night stay. (B, L, D)

**DAY SEVEN - Tour Halifax**

This morning we enjoy a little rest from our busy schedule before traveling to one of the most photographed spots in the world, Peggy's Cove, where we will enjoy an included lunch. This afternoon we return for a tour of Halifax. (CB, L)

**DAY EIGHT - Antigonish/Canso Causeway / Cape Briton and Baddeck**

This morning we continue north to Antigonish and the Canso Causeway, where we cross into Cape Briton Island. We arrive in Baddeck, the final home of Alexander Graham Bell where we check into our hotel overlooking Baddeck Harbor. We will visit the Alexander Graham Bell Museum and enjoy a wonderful dinner and entertainment (CB, D)

**DAY NINE - The famous Cabot Trail**

One of the most spectacular scenic drives in North America is the Cabot Trail and this morning you will make that awesome drive. Included lunch will be at an authentic Acadian Restaurant in beautiful Caticamp. We overnight again in Beddeck. (CB, L, D)

**DAY TEN - Prince Edwards Island**

Today we travel to the land of Anne of Green Gables, Prince Edwards Island. For many this quaint Canadian Province will be the highlight of the tour. We visit the north shore to visit Green Gables, the home which inspired Elizabeth Montgomery's famous book series then sit down to a wonderful lobster feast. We overnight in Charlottetown. (CB, D)

**DAY ELEVEN - Travel to Moncton New Brunswick**

This morning we cross one of the great engineering achievements of this decade, the Confederation Bridge between Prince Edwards Island and New Brunswick. We will overnight in Moncton, NB This afternoon we return to the US and overnight in Maine (B, L)

**DAY TWELVE - Travel to Hudson River Valley**

Today we travel through New Hampshire and Massachusetts to our overnight stay near Fishkill, NY (CB)

**DAY THIRTEEN - Hershey Chocolate World travel Shenandoah Valley**

As we travel through beautiful Pennsylvania we will take time for something sweet when we stop for lunch (on your own) at Hershey Chocolate World. We overnight near Harrisonburg, VA (CB, D)
