Mt. Rushmore / Yellowstone / Glacier National Parks



DAY ONE - Travel to Marion, IL

Westward HO! Our first day takes us through Tennessee and Kentucky to our overnight stop in Marion, IL. (D)

DAY TWO - Travel to St. Louis

Today we enter the West as did thousands of early settlers, by way of Louis, MO. We will stop to visit the Gateway Arch. You may visit the top of the Arch, plus we have included the award winning IMAX film on Lewis and Clark. We overnight in the area. (B, D)

DAY THREE - Travel to Kansas City and Sioux City

This afternoon we visit the Truman National Historic Site and then continue to Sioux City for our overnight stay. (B, D)

DAY FOUR - Travel to Mitchell SD - tour Corn Palace

We continue to follow the Missouri River as we travel into South Dakota. This afternoon we visit the famous Corn Palace in Mitchell, SD (B, D)

DAY FIVE - Travel to Badlands National Park and Rapid City, SD

The prairie of South Dakota is long and flat, but our modern motorcoach will carry us in comfort. We can only imagine how difficult it was for the early settlers to make the trip. In recent years travelers have found relief by stopping at Wall Drug Store for a FREE drink of water. For us this will be our lunch stop. In the afternoon we travel the Badlands Loop which provides a scenic wonderland of irregular ravines, fantastic ridges and variegated color alternation with grayish-white sediment. We overnight the next two nights in the Black Hills area. (B, L)

DAY SIX - Tour Black Hills of South Dakota

Mt. Rushmore, the Crazy Horse Memorial and the frontier town of Deadwood all await your visit today. Tonight we have dinner in historic Keystone SD (B, D)

DAY SEVEN - Travel to Cody WY

Today we venture into Wyoming, crossing the beautiful Big Horn Mts.. In the afternoon we arrive in Shoshone National Forest and Cody, WY where we visit the Buffalo Bill Historic Center, and attend a rodeo (B, D)

DAY EIGHT - Travel to Yellowstone National Park

This morning it's on to Yellowstone. Established in 1872, Yellowstone National Park is the world's first national park. The park is huge, covering almost 3500 square miles. Our local guide will introduce us to the very best of this "national treasure" (CB, D)

DAY NINE - Visit Grand Tetons & Old Faithful / overnight West Yellowstone, MT

This morning we visit Jackson Lake for a view of the majestic Grand Tetons. This afternoon we return to the most famous of all Yellowstone attractions, Old Faithful where we spend the afternoon. This evening we settle into West Yellowstone for a two night stay. (B, D)

DAY TEN - Explore Rest and Relaxation in West Yellowstone

Discovery Tours understands that long trips such as this can become tiring, so today you have time to explore West Yellowstone, MT at your own pace. You may also join an option afternoon excursion (no cost) into Idaho. (CB)

DAY ELEVEN - Travel to Glacier National Park

This great tour offers a wide variety of scenery. Today we travel through Western Montana to West Glacier, MT for a two night stay (CB, L)

DAY TWELVE - Glacier National Park, Montana

Get ready for views of a lifetime, as we visit Glacier National Park. The park shuttle will take you along the "Going to the Sun Hwy," where you will see scenery that is among the most beautiful in the country. We overnight in the historic East Glacier Lodge. (B, D)

DAY THIRTEEN - Travel the Lewis and Clark Trail to Eastern Montana

Today, much of the Montana landscape that Lewis & Clark crossed remains unchanged. From solitary sandstone through river canyons to mountain meadows, Montana's rivers and highways flow past scores of landmarks related to the expedition. Tonight we overnight in eastern MT. (CB, D)

DAY FOURTEEN - Travel through the Badlands of Western North Dakota to Bismarck

We continue east traveling through eastern Montana to Bismarck, ND. This afternoon we visit the Abraham Lincoln Historic Site. It was from here Gen Custer and his troops last stayed before making "Custer's last stand." (CB, L)

DAY FIFTEEN - Travel to Minneapolis/St Paul and Mall of America

Our travels take us through eastern ND and Fargo to Minneapolis for our overnight stay. This evening you have dinner (on your own) and time for shopping at the Mall of America. (CB, picnic L)

DAY SIXTEEN - Travel to Madison, WI / House on the Rock

We travel to the Wisconsin Dells for lunch before heading to the unbelievable House on the Rock. Our overnight will be in Madison, WI (CB, L)

DAY SEVENTEEN - Travel to Paducah KY

Today we travel through IL and IN to our overnight in Paducah, KY (CB, D)

DAY EIGHTEEN - Return to North Georgia
