## Day One — Travel to Charleston, WV

The story of Arron Burr and Blennerhassett Island is fascinating and you will learn much of the story this morning. After lunch (on your own) we visit Fenton Glass before traveling to Central Ohio. This evening will be a special night as we visit one of our favorite places, Warther's Carvings for a tour and candlelight dinner. (B, D)

## Day Three — Ohio Amish

The largest Amish community in the world is in central Ohio. Today we visit this beautiful farm country; touring the area with our local guide, enjoying the day at a gentle relaxed pace. We will have lunch in an Amish home, and have an included Amish style meal. (B, L)

## Day Four—Visit the Football Hall of Fame or First Ladies Library in Canton, OH, Lehman's Hardware

This morning we visit Canton, OH, home of the Football Hall of Fame. Many of our travelers have asked us to include The Football Hall of Fame to one of our tours, so if you are a NFL fan this is your chance. But don't worry, ladies— if you prefer you can visit the nearby, First Ladies Library—a museum on the history of US President's wives. This afternoon we visit Lehman's Hardware, one of the largest hardware stores dedicated to tools and supplies that do not use electricity. We overnight in Northern Kentucky. (B, D)
