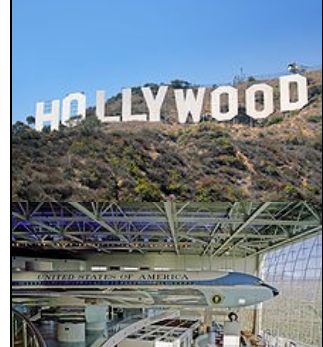

**Day One— Travel to Memphis, TN**

Travel through northern Alabama and Mississippi to our overnight stay near Memphis. (D)

Day Two—Travel to Oklahoma City, OK

We continue west, to our overnight stay near Oklahoma City (CB, D)

Day Three— Travel to Albuquerque, NM (Fly option arrives)

We start experiencing the west when we arrive in Albuquerque, NM, where we overnight near the airport. Those choosing to fly will join us at the hotel this evening. (CB, D)

Day Four— Petrified Forest National Park / travel to Flagstaff, AZ

Our travels will take us into Navajo country in western NM. After a visit to the Petrified Forest National Park we will have a two night stay in Flagstaff. (CB, L)

Day Five— Grand Canyon National Park

This morning we visit one of America's greatest natural treasures, the Grand Canyon National Park. This evening we have dinner and shopping at the Cameron Trading Post. (B, D)

Day Six— Travel to Los Angeles, CA

We travel today through the deserts of southern Nevada and California to northern LA for a two night stay. (CB, L)

Day Seven— Excursion day tour Hollywood / Reagan Library

We will have a little time to rest this morning before joining our local guide for a tour of Hollywood and North LA. (CB, D)

Day Eight—Travel to San Simeon, CA / tour Hearst Castle

As we start traveling up the beautiful west coast of California we will stop at the Reagan Presidential Library. In the afternoon we continue up the coast to our overnight stay in beautiful San Simeon. (CB, D)

Day Nine— Travel to Monterey / San Francisco

This morning we continue up the West Coast as we head to spectacular Monterey and the beautiful 17 Mile Drive. Tonight we will be in San Francisco for a two night stay. (CB)

Day Ten— Relaxation / tour San Francisco

Our centrally located hotel will allow time for you to enjoy the "City by the Bay" at a relaxed pace this morning. In the afternoon we will have a guided tour of the San Francisco Bay area. (CB,)

Day Eleven—Travel to Yosemite Nat Park

We visit one of the most popular parks in America when we tour Yosemite Nat Park. (CB, D)

Day Twelve—Travel to Lake Tahoe, NV

We explore the high Sierra Hts. as we travel through Yosemite to Lake Tahoe for our overnight stay. (B, L)

Day Thirteen—Travel to Reno / Wadsworth NV

We'll make stops in Carson City and Reno, on our way to our overnight at Wadsworth, UT (CB)

Day Fourteen—Travel to Salt Lake City, UT

We travel through northern Nevada, the salt flats and by the Great Salt Lake to our overnight stop near Salt Lake City. (CB)

Day Fifteen—Travel into Wyoming and the Rocky Mts. to Denver, CO

Today most of our journey through the majestic Rocky Mts. will be via I-80 in southern Wyoming (the old Lincoln Hwy). We overnight in Denver. (CB, D)

Day Sixteen—Morning rest time / travel to Colby, KS (return fly option)

This morning will be a time of R&R. (Those choosing to return by air will depart for Atlanta.)

This afternoon those returning by coach will travel to Colby, KS for our overnight stay. (CB)

Day Seventeen—Abilene, KS and the Eisenhower Presidential Library / travel to Kansas City

We continue east to Abilene, the boyhood home of Pres. Eisenhower, where we visit the Eisenhower Presidential Library. We continue to Kansas City for our overnight stay. (CB)

Day Eighteen—Union Station, St. Louis / travel to Paducah, KY

We travel through central Missouri, making a brief stop at the Gateway Arch in St. Louis, before continuing to Paducah of our overnight. (B)

Day Nineteen—Return to Northeast GA (B)
