

## Savannah/Okefenokee Swamp Tour

### Day One

Depart Early from School

Stop in **Andersonville** for lunch and some Civil War history

Head to **Tifton** and the **Agrirama** where students will experience life on a Georgia farm in the late 1800s

Dinner at the **Agrirama** then on to **Waycross** to spend the night

### Day Two

Visit the **Okefenokee Swamp** – ride the train and boats for a tour of the swamp, get up close to swamp inhabitants with “Eye on Nature” show provided by park staff

Lunch

Headed to **Savannah** (stop by the beaches at **Tybee Island** on the way!)

Visit **Old Fort Jackson** where students become members of the Georgia Militia!

Dinner in Savannah

Visit Savannah's historic district with a guided Ghost Tour – learn some of the folklore and legends of this great Southern city!

### Day Three

Take a **Trolley** ride through downtown Savannah to check out all the history, architecture and enchanting stories of this old Georgia city.

Tour an historic venue such as **First African Baptist Church** for an up close look at history.

Enjoy some supervised souvenir shopping on the historical **River Street** in Savannah and watching the ships roll in!

Have lunch and head home!
